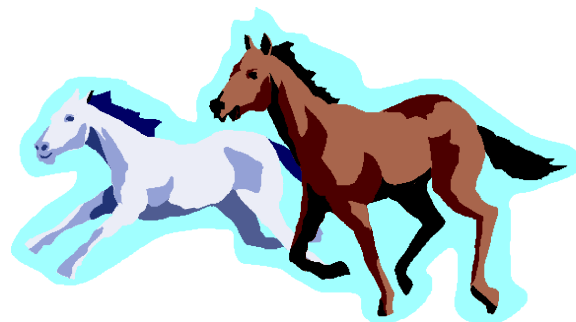
Camp Goals:

Camp Schedule
